Commercial & Large Vehicle Clarification Policy—May 2013

A commercial vehicle is defined as, but not limited to, any vehicle meeting any of the following criteria.

- Any vehicle licensed to a business and used for profit.
- Any vehicle used on commercial or construction projects for hauling equipment and/or tools for profit.
- Any vehicle required to be licensed as a commercial vehicle per the Idaho Transportation Department.
- Any vehicle that is 3/4 ton or larger, equipped with tool boxes or racks, and is too large to fit in a residential garage.
- Standard In-Bed Storage Boxes utilized for non-commercial/construction purposes, that do not extend above the bed by more

- than 6 inches nor extend beyond the bed, are allowed.
- Built-in tool boxes and equipment storage boxes such as those that extend the full bed length or more than 6 inches above the bed are classified as commercial and are prohib-
